- Build relationships and community within small groups

Requirements:

- Commit to 2-8 hrs per week between the hours of 3:00 PM--6:00 PM Monday Thursday
- Patience with students who struggle academically
- A belief that every student has the desire and the ability to succeed
- Strong academic record
- Growth mindset and desire for feedback
- Strong interest in working with underserved youth
- Prior tutoring experience a plus
